






The majority of our elementary school students are not proficient in Math, Science, or English. Science Proficiency less than 30%, Math less than 40%, English below 50%.








MIDDLE / HIGH SCHOOLS

Extremely Low Math & Science Scores. Not prepared for STEM careers.

75% of our upper school students are not proficient in science. A full 85% of our high school students are not proficient in Algebra II. English Proficiency drops from 70% at the middle school level to below 60% in high school.


Middle School % Proficient






Poor Standardized Test Scores 2022 Post-Covid Assessment

% of Students who scored in the lowest category in Fall 2022 Start Strong State Assessment



2022 Total Budget from all Revenue Sources



2/3 of West Amwell Taxes goes to School District



School Portion of Taxes vs. \$2.1 million for West Amwell **Township**



Spend per student is skyrocketing






Spending Breakdown Per Student

Spending Increases Over Time Per Student


Per Pupil Dollar Budget Change 2017 to 2023
